Founded in Kiev, Ukraine, in 1851, **A La Vieille Russie** brings a time-honored history of working with regal pieces to a new NYC location. The family-run business first found its home in Manhattan in 1941 and now opens a new location on Fifth Avenue, where curators offer fine jewelry, furniture and paintings. Housed inside the modern, open space are antique Russian artworks, 18th century gold snuff boxes, and European and American antique jewelry glittering with amethyst, jade, sapphires and rubies. The company was also instrumental in introducing Carl Fabergé's work to American audiences through museum exhibits.
